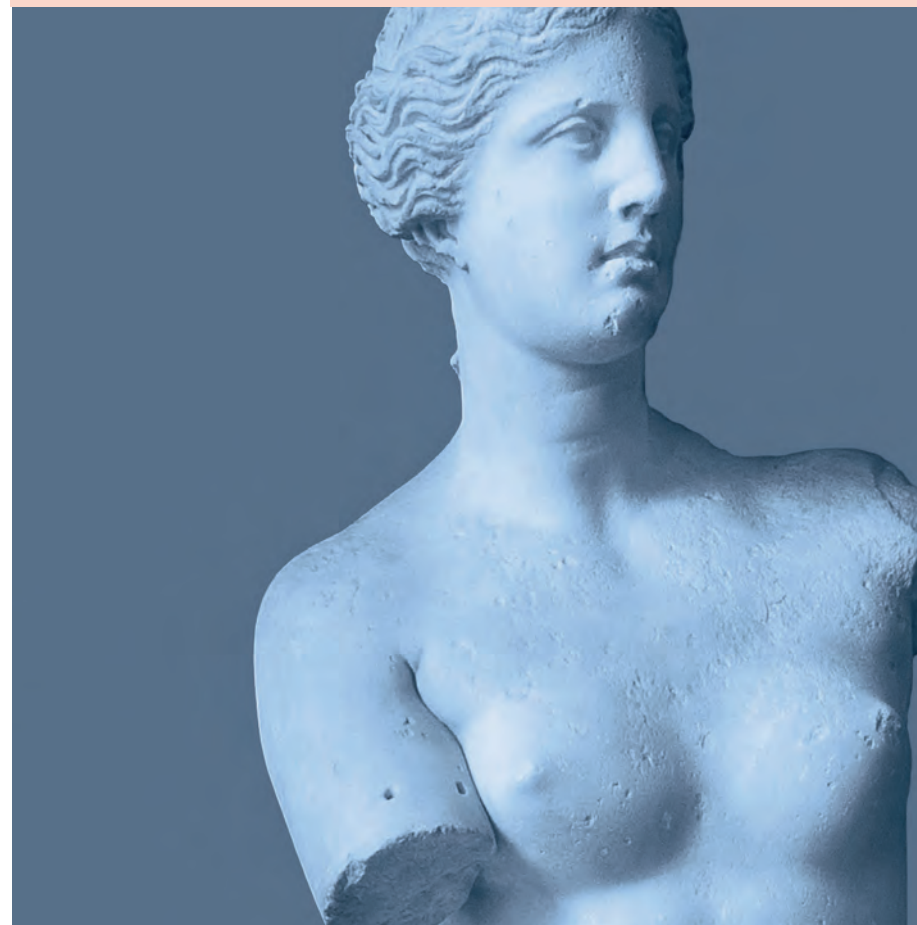

# IDKD offers interactive, organ-based teaching workshops with annually changing topics.

## Concept

IDKD – International Diagnostic Course Davos – offers interactive teaching workshops, presented by a highly qualified international faculty. IDKD courses are organ-based with annually changing topics: Chest, Heart and Vascular System – Abdomen and Pelvis – Musculoskeletal – Brain, Head and Neck, Spine.

IDKD is currently offering courses in Davos, Switzerland, in Athens, Greece, Beijing and Hong Kong, China, and Rio de Janeiro, Brazil.

IDKD 2016 in Greece will be run as an intensive course, featuring 14 workshops spread over 3½ days, this time covering the imaging of the Chest, Heart and Vascular System. During the workshops, participants study and discuss the case material. Teachers then guide the participants through the cases, discuss the differential diagnosis, present additional material and ask questions. Teachers can easily be approached during breaks to individually discuss unsolved problems. Participants will be divided into groups of approximately 50-60 participants and are encouraged to bring their own laptop (PC or Mac) to the workshops for case viewing on the USB sticks provided. Moreover, the teachers will present their cases in a video loop on the classroom VCR projector. In addition to the workshops, “hot topics” in radiology, new developments and overviews including interventional techniques will be discussed in highlight lectures and demonstrated during practical workshops presented by experts. Practical workshops will be held during lunch breaks.
